For example, 3+7

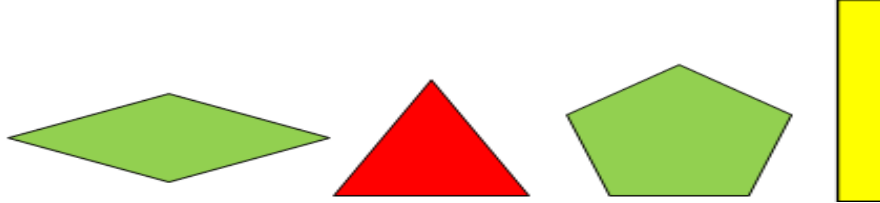
Writing Challenge of the Day:

Week Five: Tuesday

Word Problem of the Day:

Sort these shapes. Tell how you sorted them.



Writing Challenge:

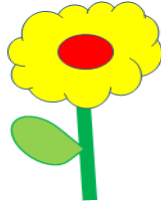
Close your eyes and picture a butterfly. What colours are on your butterfly. Print the colours. Can you draw a picture of your butterfly?

(Help your child stretch out the sounds. Maybe he only recognizes the first sound – that is great! Just print that one sound. If your child doesn't recognize the first letter, teach that one letter today)

Week Five: Wednesday

Word Problem of the Day:

Tony planted 3 flowers in his garden on Monday. He planted 6 on Tuesday. How many flowers are in Tony's garden?



Writing Challenge:

Look around your house and print 5 words that you find. (Look on cereal boxes, clothing etc.)

Week Five: Thursday

Word Problem of the Day:

Joey has some cookies in his lunch. He eats 2 and his friend Ella eats 2. There are no more cookies in Joey's lunch. How many cookies did he have in his lunch?

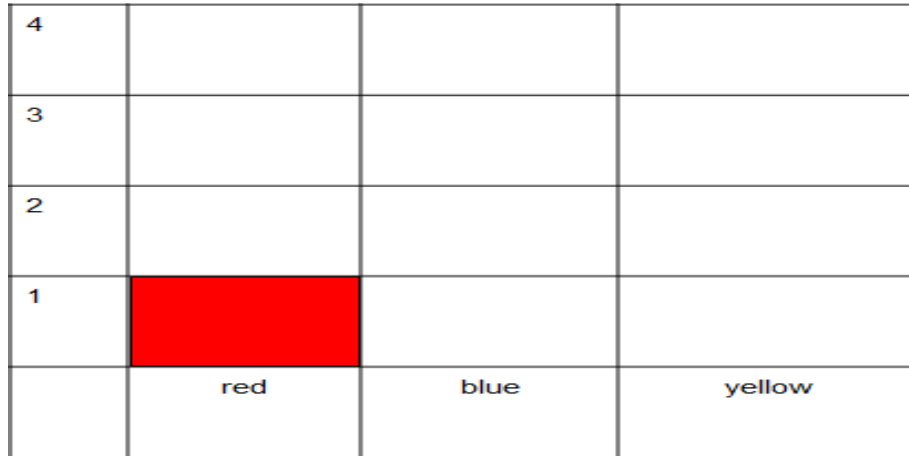
Writing Challenge
